


2015 Mourvèdre

Stillwater Creek Vineyard Columbia Valley AVA

Another first for Brian Carter Cellars is the ONE Mourvèdre. This variety, originally from Spain, is well know in Southern France where it makes up the M in the famous GSM blends which are now made around the world. Brian Carter Cellars has been using Mourvèdre since 2004 when it was first incorporated into our Byzance blend. During that period, this variety has been gaining both popularity and respect from many Washington winemakers. Mourvèdre is a demanding grape. When the right winemaker, vineyard and vintage come together it can make a stellar wine as can be seen from this select offering. This very dark wine has a complex nose that will keep you coming back for more. As the wine opens look for blackberries, white pepper, rose petals, anise, tar and vanilla. On the palate you will find mouth filling flavors and food friendly acidity. Drink this wine with just about anything - how about lamb lollipops Provencal with olive mashed potatoes.
