


2013 Cabernet Sauvignon

Klipsun Vineyard Red Mountain AVA

Typical of the wines from this great vineyard, which tend to be tightly woven when young, I held this wine back from release until I tasted it recently. The intensity of the fruit shows it has many years to go before it reaches its peak but it is starting to enter a period where it will offer great enjoyment. Young at heart if not in years, I recommend decanting this wine.

Tasting Notes: Very dark in color, the nose opens to a panoply of fruit including blackberry, cassis sand raspberry with hints of floral bouquet and fine oak. On the palate the wine has tannins that have been tamed with time, a prefect acid balance for food and a fruit intensity that lingers. Enjoy with perfectly cooked dry rubbed steak of your choice; for me it would be a thick medium-rare ribeye right off the grill.
